High School District 214 Internship Program Process

- 1. Our formalized Internship program provides students an opportunity for advanced skill development and to engage in meaningful work within their identified career areas of interest.
- 2. Students take a sequence of courses within an identified career pathway, including orientation or survey, developmental, and capstone level courses.
 - a. Internships are included as an opportunity within a capstone course of a career pathway
- 3. Student applies for the Internship program. A complete application consists of:
 - a. Student Application
 - b. Parent Recommendation and Consent forms
 - i. Medical Insurance form
 - ii. Syllabus Agreement
 - iii. Transportation form
 - iv. Off-campus Release
 - v. Internship Agreement
 - c. 2 Teacher Recommendations
- 4. Student's attendance, grades, and discipline records are screened
- 5. Every internship is customized so detailed information is obtained during an interview with the applicant
 - a. This information, along with data obtained from the screening, is entered into our relational management system CSO
- 6. Acceptance emails are sent to students with next steps including enrollment in our LMS (I use Moodle 2)
- 7. Our team searches for internship placements based on student career interests and what our industry partners can provide
- 8. Once a placement is secured:
 - a. A placement email is sent to the student with detailed information and next steps
 - b. An email confirmation is sent to the industry partner
- 9. Evaluation and Collection of Data/feedback
 - a. Our team conduct site visits
 - b. Half way through the semester:
 - i. Student completes a self-evaluation
 - ii. Site supervisor completes an evaluation on the intern
 - c. Conclusion of the semester
 - i. Student completes a self-evaluation
 - ii. Supervisor completes an evaluation on the intern
- 10. Grading
 - a. Student earns .5 credit for the Fall or Spring semester (5-10 hrs/wk)
 - b. Student earns 1.0 credit for the Summer semester (120 hrs over 6 weeks)
 - c. The overall grade is comprised of student performance at the internship site, along with assignments completed via Moodle 2
 - i. Reflective journaling; forums; analysis paper; ePortfolio
