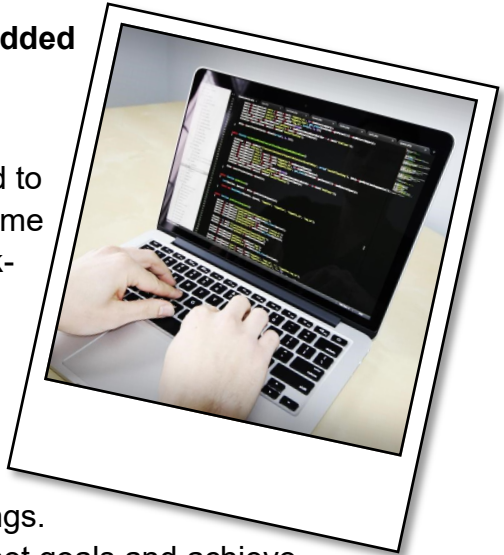

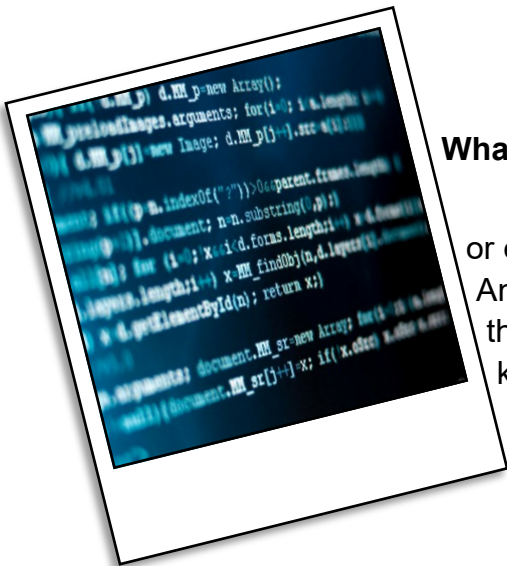


What were your goals in college?
