

## **Usage Rights**

A Creative Commons (CC) license is one of several public copyright licenses that enable the free distribution of an otherwise copyrighted work. A CC license is used when an author wants to give people the right to share, use, and build upon a work that they have created. CC provides an author flexibility (for example, they might choose to allow only non-commercial uses of their own work) and protects the people who use or redistribute an author's work from concerns of copyright infringement as long as they abide by the conditions that are specified in the license by which the author distributes the work. The CC licenses are selected based on: the resource is already available with the license visible or you're creating a new resource and apply a cc license. The OER doesn't apply a license to anything by learning lists and sets. All resources, already have a license applied when they're tagged or uploaded.
