


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About Illinois Open Educational Resources (IOER)








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Curate with Libraries

- Embed your library on any website.



Personal Library






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Organization Management

- To view the organizations you are associated with go to Dashboard and select **My Dashboard**
- Under My Stuff on the left side you will select Organization Administration.
- Organization Management allows you to:
 - Create a new organization
 - See all of your organizations
 - Manage members
 - Invitation email
 - Upload CSV file
 - Remove
 - Assign roles
 - Manage organization libraries.
 - Manage organization Learning Lists.


